

MURIWAI BLOKARTING

Muriwai Beach Sunday 23rd May 2021

If you have never heard of this fun sport, you will have to come along and try them out. It is a land yacht, and you determine the speed and direction you race along the beach, by rope controls. All training given by the surf school instructors. Blokarts can only be done on a windy day (15-20 knots), 2 hours either side of low tide. Low tide is 3.30 to 5.30pm

Further info: Meet at the Muriwai Surf School, 458 Motutara Road, Muriwai at 3pm. The instructor will give us a briefing and explain how to use the blokart. If more than 6 people, we will have to share the booked time in rotation as they only have 6 karts. This may also change the costing. Bring: Weather conditions on the day may mean you might get wet and sandy! Comfortable clothes & shoes which you do not mind getting wet, sunglasses, sunblock, wind jacket and gloves.
