### **ONEHUNGA TO HENDERSON CYCLE RIDE**






**Secret Santa:** This year we are doing something slightly different. The committee are sponsoring the gifts. You will get an entry ticket for this when you sign in on the day.

Non-members may attend some club events. Members have priority and a surcharge may be applied to non-members. Contact the event organiser directly to make a booking for any event.

If you have confirmed to go to an event where the ticket is prepaid by the organiser, or accommodation booked, pay by the due date. The ticket is still your responsibility to pay. You can sell it or give it away.

If accommodation has been made for you by the organiser, it is your responsibility to either pay the whole amount, or find someone else to take your place

If you cannot attend on the day, advise the organiser immediately, as they may have people wishing to attend.
